Problem Description

This package of works will upgrade roads across Queensland to address identified road safety and fatigue management issues that contribute to vehicle crashes.

The works will target road safety improvements and include wide centrelines, audio tactile line marking, shoulder widening, and safety barriers as appropriate. This package will target both urban and regional roads with a history of fatigue related crashes.

Project Benefits

Benefits include:

- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Improved accessibility and connectivity of road networks.

Project Timelines

Construction of the projects in this package is expected to begin in mid to late-2020 and is scheduled to be completed in mid-2021.
