Toodyay Road Upgrade - Jingaling Brook to Toodyay

Problem Description

Toodyay Road forms part of the Roe Highway to Toodyay Route that links the north-eastern Wheatbelt to Perth. The route carries a large volume of commuter and tourist traffic, and heavy vehicles. Toodyay Road, within the Wheatbelt section from east of Jingaling Brook Road to Toodyay, is deficient in many areas including the seal and shoulder width, lack of overtaking lanes and roadside hazards in the clear zones. Between January 2014 and December 2018, Toodyay Road had the highest rate of killed and serious injury crashes within the Wheatbelt region.

The project will widen the seal on two sections of Toodyay Road between Jingaling Brook and Toodyay, with the provision for a passing lane within the Jingaling Brook section.

Project Benefits

Benefits include:

- Improve road safety for all road users.
- Improve efficiency and network reliability.
- The project is expected to support 45 direct and indirect jobs during the construction phase of the project.

Project Timelines

 This project is expected to commence construction in late-2020 and be completed by early-2021.
