Australian Capital Territory

The Australian Government is investing over \$90 million for vital land transport infrastructure projects in the ACT in the October 2022-23 Budget to improve safety and reduce travel times.

This includes committing funding to progress the Canberra Light Rail Stage 2A project, as part of a strategy to ease congestion and improve access.

This Budget follows a repositioning of the Infrastructure Investment Program to respond to market capacity constraints, creating a more sustainable infrastructure pipeline while continuing to support priorities for the ACT.

Key projects

Canberra Light Rail – Stage 2A

The Australian Government has committed a further \$85.9 million for the Canberra Light Rail – Stage 2A project. This brings the total Australian Government funding to this project to \$218.4 million.

Canberra Light Rail – Stage 2A will help reduce congestion, and improve community connectivity and travel times.



Garden City Cycle Route

The Australian Government has committed \$5 million for the Garden City Cycle Route project, which will deliver a safe and functional cycle route connecting Canberra's inner north with



the city. The cycle route will include a mix of off-road shared paths and connected on-road cycle lanes.

The project will help reduce traffic congestion on the roads, while also encouraging people to be active and improve their health.
