Projects within the Tasmanian Roads Corridor:

West Tamar Highway targeted upgrades between Exeter and Launceston

The West Tamar Highway runs from Launceston to Greens Beach in the far north east of Tasmania. This project will deliver targeted upgrades between Exeter and Launceston to make this section of the West Tamar Highway safer and more efficient.

Tasman Highway Sideling Upgrade - Stage 2

The Project will upgrade approximately 9 kilometres of the Tasman Highway at the Sideling between the access road near the Sideling Lookout and the Corkerys Road intersection.

Great Eastern Drive Tourism Support - additional packages

The project will provide safety improvements to a portion of the Tasman Highway referred to as the Great Eastern Drive which covers the section of the highway from Orford through to St Helens. The improvements include road widening, adequate safe overtaking opportunities and intersection upgrades.

Tasmanian Roads Package - Northern Roads Package - Stage 2

This project will deliver upgrades to the Bass Highway, the East Tamar Highway and the West Tamar Highway. The upgrades may include road widening, overtaking opportunities, intersection upgrades and improvements to cycling and pedestrian infrastructure.
