Projects within the Industry Roads Corridor:

Sandover Highway Upgrade

The Project will upgrade and seal 20 kilometres of the Sandover Highway.

Carpentaria Highway Upgrade

The Project will involve planning for, reconstruction and associated works of approximately 140 kilometres of the Carpentaria Highway, commencing at the Stuart Highway.

Roper Highway Upgrade (Stage 1)

The project upgraded and sealed 4.5 kilometres of the Roper Highway.

Roper Highway Upgrade (Stage 2)

The Project will upgrade and seal approximately 18.9 kilometres of the Roper Highway between Wilton Bridge and Ngukurr to a two-lane sealed standard.

Carpentaria Highway Strengthening & Widening

The Project will upgrade the Carpentaria Highway between the Tablelands Highway and MacArthur River Mine.

Buntine Highway Upgrade

The Project will upgrade priority sections of the Buntine Highway to deliver flood immunity, safety improvements and pavement strengthening and widening works along the route.

Newman to Katherine Upgrade (Northern Territory) - Scoping and Investigations

This planning project involves scoping and investigation works for upgrades including design and preparatory works for future projects.
