Projects within the Regional Roads Corridor:

Port Keats Road - Wadeye to Palumpa (Nganmarriyanga)

The Project will upgrade, widen and seal Port Keats Road from Wadeye to Palumpa.

Remote Community Access Roads Upgrades

The Project will upgrade and seal priority access roads to communities including Imanpa (Imanpa Road), Emu Point (Emu Point Access) and Mungkarta (McLaren Creek Access).

Arnhem Highway Duplication - Stuart Highway to Kostka Road

The Project will construct a four-lane divided road from the Stuart Highway to Kostka Road and a pedestrian crossing and signalisation at the Stuart and Arnhem Highway intersection.

Central Arnhem Road Upgrade

The Project will involve sealing, reconstructing, widening, and flood immunity improvements to priority sections of the route to a fit-for-purpose standard.

Nationwide Freight Highway Upgrade Program (NT) - Central Arnhem Road

This Project will contribute to the upgrade and sealing of Central Arnhem Road.

Jabiru Road Upgrades (Kakadu National Park)

The Project will upgrade roads to support access to the township of Jabiru and Kakadu National Park.

Regional Roads Productivity Package - Arnhem Link Road

The Project will upgrade five sections of the Arnhem Link Road across three separate packages of works. Works to be delivered include, sealing and flood immunity works such as the installation of drainage culverts and concrete causeways.

Arnhem Highway - Adelaide River Floodplain Upgrade

The project upgraded the Arnhem Highway to improve flood immunity at the Adelaide River floodplain. This involved the construction of 6.6 kilometres of new road alignment and ground improvements and drainage works at Beatrice Hill.

Arnhem Highway Upgrade at Beatrice Hill

The project delivered a new 2.8 kilometres section of the Arnhem Highway including installation of bridge, culvert and drainage structures to improve the flood immunity of the highway at the Adelaide River flood plain.
