The Australian Government is committed to ensuring the sustainability of the 10-year, over \$120 billion infrastructure investment pipeline, delivering nationally significant projects while considering the impacts of inflation and cost of living pressures on Australians.

Through the 2024-25 MYEFO, the Government is focused on managing cost pressures by implementing strategies for existing projects and maintaining our commitment to responsible financial management.

Over **\$60 million** has been committed towards existing projects to ensure the continued delivery of essential road infrastructure upgrades within the Northern Territory.

As at 2024-25 MYEFO, the Government's total commitment to the Northern Territory under the Infrastructure Investment Program, over the next 10-years is \$2.8 billion, including \$2.5 billion towards major road projects and \$290 million for smaller projects and programs such as the Roads to Recovery, Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure and the Black Spots programs.

The Government remains dedicated to working for all Australians by delivering nationally significant infrastructure projects that enhance productivity and resilience, improve liveability, and promote sustainability.

Projects receiving additional funding

Through the 2024–25 MYEFO, the Australian Government has committed over **\$60 million** to support the delivery of existing projects.

Carpentaria Highway Upgrade

This project will deliver approximately 175 kilometres of improved road conditions along the Carpentaria Highway, commencing at the Stuart Highway. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$58.3 million** towards the project.

This additional funding will allow further road improvement works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$203.3 million**.



This project will deliver upgrades to priority sections of the Stuart, Victoria and Barkly Highways; improving road conditions and safety. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$2.4 million** towards the project.

This additional funding will allow further road improvement works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$171.8 million**.
