Beerburrum to Nambour Rail Upgrade

Commitment

At the 2024-25 Budget the Australia Government committed an additional **\$226.7 million** towards the Beerburrum to Nambour Rail Upgrade to address cost pressures and support the full delivery of the project.

This brings the Australian Government’s commitment towards the project to **\$616.7 million**.

Total Commitment: \$1,004.2 million
Queensland Government Commitment: \$387.5 million

Project Scope

This Project will deliver upgrades to the North Coast Line between Beerburrum and Nambour to increase capacity and support future growth and demand in the region. The works will include duplication of the track between Beerburrum and Beerwah, expansion of park and ride facilities, and construction of road overpasses at Burgess Street, Barrs Road and Beerburrum Road.

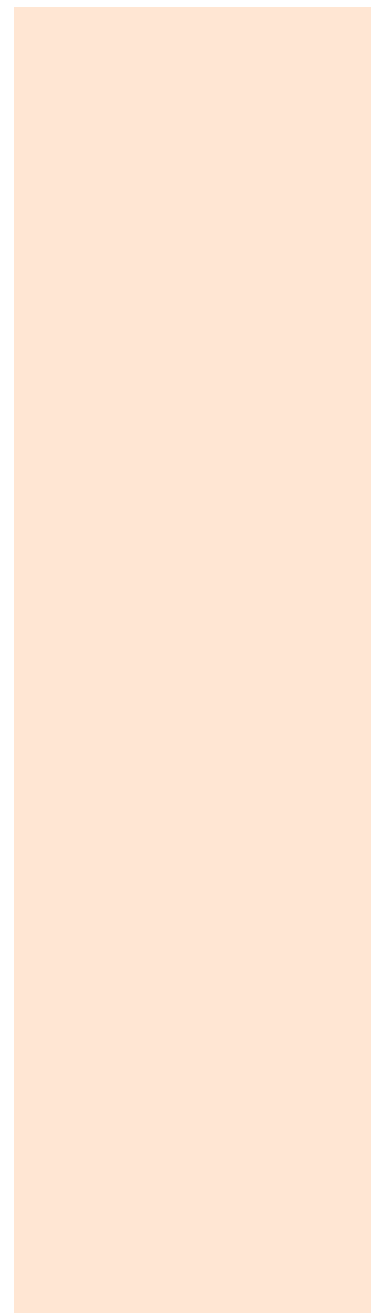
Timeline

Early works commenced in early 2021 and completed in late 2023. Main construction timeframes will be confirmed as part of the completion of detailed design.

Project Objectives

- Track duplication and improved rail infrastructure to deliver improved capacity and reliability
- Reduced travel times and increased passengers and freight services for the growing Sunshine Coast region
- Supports increased rail patronage for passengers and freight, alleviating pressures on the congested Bruce Highway
