# Bruce Highway Safety Package

## Infrastructure Investment Program

<b>Corridor Description</b>	The Bruce Highway Safety Package Corridor includes packages containing numerous smaller safety works projects over the length of the Bruce Highway from Brisbane to Cairns.

## Projects within the Bruce Highway Safety Package Corridor:

### **Bruce Highway - Additional Funding for Black Spots, Rest Areas and Safety Upgrades**

The package will deliver high priority safety improvement works at various sections on the Bruce Highway including intersection upgrades, rest area upgrades and wide centre line treatments.

### **Bruce Highway - Bruce Highway Safety Package**

The package will deliver safety enhancements at priority sections along the Bruce Highway, including installation of wire-rope barriers, intersection upgrades, pavement widening, resurfacing, wide centre line treatments and culvert upgrades.

### **Bruce Highway - Overtaking Lanes**

The package will deliver new overtaking lanes or upgrade of existing overtaking lanes on priority section of the Bruce Highway.

### **Bruce Highway - Roads Operations Improvement Projects**

The package will provide Intelligent Transport System (ITS) infrastructure at various locations over the length of the Bruce Highway.

### **Bruce Highway – Targeted Safety Program**

The program will deliver safety projects north of Gympie. The Project will install safety barriers, wide centre lines and audio tactile line marking, construct wider shoulders, increase run off areas and remove roadside hazards, reseal and rehabilitate pavement, construct new overtaking lanes and rest areas and upgrade narrow bridges, intersections, signage, sight lines and drainage.

## Projects within the Cape York Corridor:

### Cape York Community Access Roads

This project will seal sections of several Community Access Roads that connect to the Peninsula Developmental Road.

### Cape York Region Package

The Cape York Region Package will consist of upgrading and sealing priority sections of the Peninsula Developmental Road, five sections of the Endeavour Valley Road and delivering community infrastructure projects to nine local government areas on the Cape.

### Northern Peninsula Road - Jardine River Crossing Upgrade

Business Case development for the Northern Peninsula Road - Jardine River Crossing Upgrade project.

### Peninsula Developmental Road

The project will upgrade and seal sections of the Peninsula Developmental Road including the construction of a new crossing over Archer River.
