Project Scope

This project will upgrade the Bruce Highway between the Gateway Motorway and Gympie Arterial Road interchange and north of the Dohles Rocks Road interchange. Key elements include construction of new collector-distributor roads and bridges across the Pine River, a continuous shared path and environmental features including noise barriers, fauna fencing and fauna underpasses.

This commitment builds on previous investments made by the Australian Government to increase capacity and traffic flow on the Gateway Motorway and Bruce Highway. It will address a key pinch point ahead of the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

Australian Government Commitment: \$812.5 million
