Projects within the Cunningham Highway Corridor:

Cunningham Highway - Amberley Interchange Upgrade

The project is expected to deliver upgrades to Amberley interchange on the Cunningham Highway with the aim of improving safety and easing congestion.

Cunningham Highway - Eight Mile Intersection Upgrade

The project delivered a grade-separated option at the Eight Mile Intersection, including a new overpass for traffic on the New England Highway travelling from Toowoomba to Warwick.

Cunningham Highway - Planning (including Amberley Interchange)

The project is expected to deliver two business cases on priority areas on the Cunningham Highway including the Ipswich-Rosewood Road Intersection.

Cunningham Highway - Safety Package

The project is expected to deliver safety upgrades along the Cunningham Highway between Warwick and Willowbank including pavement treatments and widening, wide centreline treatments, installation of audio tactile line markings and additional guardrail treatments
