Projects within the Cunningham Highway Corridor:

Cunningham Highway - Safety Package

The Cunningham Highway Safety Package will deliver safety upgrades along the Cunningham Highway between Warwick and Willowbank including pavement treatments and widening, wide centreline treatments, installation of audio tactile line markings and additional guardrail treatments.

Cunningham Highway - Planning (including Amberley Interchange)

This project involves a package of planning works on the Cunningham Highway to identify future upgrade priorities that can reduce travel times and improve safety and reliability.

Cunningham Highway - Eight Mile Intersection Upgrade

This project delivered a low-cost grade separated option at the Eight Mile Intersection, including a new overpass for traffic on the New England Highway travelling from Toowoomba to Warwick.
