<b>Corridor Description</b>	The Gore Highway Corridor is broadly located on the National Land Transport Network in Queensland between the Leichhardt Highway intersection and the Warrego Highway intersection.

## Projects within the Gore Highway Corridor:

### **Gore Highway (Millmerran - Goondiwindi): Wyaga Creek Flood Improvement**

The project is expected to upgrade the Wyaga Creek crossing on the Gore Highway, north of Goondiwindi, to replace the existing low-immunity culvert with a higher flood immunity bridge structure. The project will also deliver pavement widening and rehabilitation works on the approaches to the new bridge.

### **Toowoomba to Seymour - Gore Highway (Pittsworth to Millmerran) Road Surface Rehabilitation**

The Project delivered road surface rehabilitation treatments to the Gore Highway between Pittsworth and Millmerran, including sealing, waterproofing, reinforced seals and reinforced overlays
