Projects within the Gore Highway Corridor:

Gore Highway (Millmerran - Goondiwindi): Wyaga Creek Flood Improvement

This project will upgrade the Wyaga Creek crossing on the Gore Highway, north of Goondiwindi, to replace the existing low-immunity culvert with a higher flood immunity bridge structure. The project will also deliver pavement widening and rehabilitation works on the approaches to the new bridge.

Toowoomba to Seymour - Gore Highway (Pittsworth to Millmerran) Road Surface Rehabilitation

The Project delivered road surface rehabilitation treatments to the Gore Highway between Pittsworth and Millmerran, including sealing, waterproofing, reinforced seals and reinforced overlays.
