### Project Scope

This project will undertake design and pre-construction activities to support improvements to the overpass at Exit 45 on the M1 Pacific Motorway, northern Gold Coast. Key elements include design development, cost and risk definition, and pre-construction planning to support future delivery.

This commitment builds on previous investments made by the Australian Government to upgrade the southbound off-ramp at Exit 45 on the M1 Pacific Motorway and the Australian Government's over \$2.2 billion commitment since 2020 to improve the M1 Pacific Motorway between Brisbane and the Gold Coast.

### Funding

**Total Commitment:** \$20 million

**Australian Government Commitment:** \$10 million

**Queensland Government Commitment:** \$10 million

### Benefits

*This planning work will inform future Australian Government investment in the delivery phase. Anticipated benefits of a construction project may include:*

- Improved network efficiency

### Delivery Timeframes
