Connecting Australians I Enriching Communities I Empowering Regions Supporting priority land transport infrastructure projects.

The Australian Government is committed to ensuring the sustainability of the 10-year, over \$120 billion infrastructure investment pipeline, delivering nationally significant projects while considering the impacts of inflation and cost of living pressures on Australians.

Through the 2024-25 MYEFO, the Government is focused on managing cost pressures by implementing strategies for existing projects and maintaining our commitment to responsible financial management.

Over **\$500 million** has been committed towards existing projects to ensure the continued delivery of essential road infrastructure upgrades within Queensland, including almost **\$260 million** for projects along the Bruce Highway.

As at 2024-25 MYEFO, the Government's total commitment to Queensland under the Infrastructure Investment Program, over the next 10-years is \$21.8 billion, including \$19.6 billion towards major road and rail projects and \$2.2 billion for smaller projects and programs such as the Roads to Recovery, Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure and the Black Spots programs.

The Government remains dedicated to working for all Australians by delivering nationally significant infrastructure projects that enhance productivity and resilience, improve liveability, and promote sustainability.

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Projects receiving additional funding

Through the 2024–25 MYEFO, the Australian Government has committed **\$504.6 million** to support the delivery of existing projects, including **\$259.9 million** for projects along the Bruce Highway.

Bruce Highway - O'Connell River to Proserpine Flood Immunity Upgrade (Goorganga Floodplain)

This project will deliver improved flood immunity on the Bruce Highway south of Proserpine on the Goorganga Floodplain, including Thompson Creek, Goorganga Creek and Lethebrook Creek. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$200 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will allow the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$376 million**.

Moggill Road Corridor Upgrade

This project is replacing the Indooroopilly roundabout with an overpass over Moggill Road and implementing a signalised intersection at Coonan Street and Moggill Road. This project is also upgrading the existing service road to connect Moggill Road with Coonan Street Bridge, removing the intersection at Nelson Parade, providing new onroad cycling facilities along Moggill Road between Payne Street and Indooroopilly Shopping Centre, and providing footpaths through the area. The Australian Government has committed an additional \$78.5 million towards the project.

This additional funding will allow the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$128.5 million**.

Brisbane Metro

The project is delivering two high-frequency metro lines across 21 kilometres of existing busway that links Eight Mile Plains, Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital, and the University of Queensland Lakes to the Brisbane CBD. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$51.5 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will address cost pressures associated with delivery and allow the project to be delivered in full with services operational from late January 2025. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$351.5 million**.

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Bruce Highway - Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway

This project upgraded a 7 kilometre section of the Bruce Highway between the Caloundra Road Interchange and the Sunshine Motorway. The project was completed in August 2021 and provided a six-lane divided highway and upgraded the Caloundra Road Interchange, and the Sunshine Motorway Interchange. The Australian Government has committed an additional \$25.8 million towards the project identified through post completion activities.



This additional funding addressed cost pressures and supported the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$711.6 million**.

Chambers Flat Road upgrade, Park Ridge

This project will widen Chambers Flat Road between Park Ridge Road and Derby Road from two to four lanes while also providing the signalisation of key intersections and upgrades to the stormwater system. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$23.5 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will address cost pressures associated with delivery and allow the commencement of works to occur in 2025. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$36.4 million**.

M1 Pacific Motorway Upgrade Program - Exit 41 and Exit 49

This project has developed and delivered upgrades for both Exit 41 and 49 on the M1 Pacific Motorway including upgrades to intersections, roundabouts, and on/off ramps. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$20.7 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will allow the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$117 million**.

Mooloolah River Interchange Upgrade (Packages 1 and 2)

The Australian Government has agreed to contribute an additional **\$19.9 million** towards finalising the project.



The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$36.6 million**.

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Youngs Crossing Road, Lawnton

This project will upgrade Youngs Crossing Road, Lawnton including upgrades to the existing road and construction of a new bridge over the North Pine River. These works will improve flood immunity, safety and road capacity. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$18.9 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will address cost pressures associated with land acquisition and delivery and support main construction to start in 2025. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now \$51.6 million.

Bruce Highway - Goorganga Overtaking Lanes

This project will deliver new northbound and southbound overtaking lanes on the Bruce Highway south of Proserpine. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$12 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will allow the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$24 million**.

Torbanlea Pialba Road Upgrade

This project will provide upgrades to targeted sections of Torbanlea Pialba Road, including intersection upgrades, road realignment, and the construction of a new bridge over Beelbi Creek. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$9.5 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will allow the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$33.5 million**.

Beenleigh Connection Road - City Road Intersection Upgrade, Beenleigh

This project will deliver the upgrade of the intersection of Beenleigh Connection Road and City Road to reduce high levels of congestion and queuing. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$8 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will address cost pressures associated with land acquisition and delivery and will allow the project to commence as soon as possible. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$15 million**.

Bruce Highway - Jumper Creek Upgrade

This project provided flood immunity upgrades to a 900 metre section of the Bruce Highway near Jumper Creek north of Mackay. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$8 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will allow the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$26.4 million**.

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Cunningham Highway - Safety Package

This project will deliver safety upgrades along the Cunningham Highway between Warwick and Willowbank, including pavement treatments, widening, centreline treatments, installation of audio tactile line markings, and additional guardrail treatments. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$7.9 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will address cost pressures associated delivery, including an increase in material costs and supply chain shortages, and allow the safety upgrades to continue along the Cunningham Highway. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$31.8 million**.

Bruce Highway - Cairns Southern Access Corridor - Stage 4 - Kate to Aumuller

This project upgraded 2.6 kilometres of the Bruce Highway from Kate Street to Aumuller Street in Cairns. The project widened this section from four to six lanes, improved access and egress and upgraded numerous intersections. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$5.7 million** towards the project.



This additional funding addressed cost pressures and supported the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$95 million**.

Bruce Highway - Dallachy Road Flood Immunity Upgrade

This project will upgrade the Bruce Highway to improve flood immunity between Dallachy Road and Dean Road south of Tully. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$5.6 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will allow the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$14.4 million**.

Beenleigh-Beaudesert Road Upgrade, Beenleigh

This project will deliver upgrades to Beenleigh-Beaudesert Road between Milne Street and Tallangandra Road intersections to a four-lane, two-way road, providing an extended and signalised right-turn lane as well as on-road cycling facilities and offroad shared paths. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$4 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will address cost pressures associated with delivery, including an increase in material costs and labour availability. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$10 million**.

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Bruce Highway - Knobels Road Intersection Upgrade

This project will upgrade a 1.1 kilometre section of the Bruce Highway at the intersection of Knobels Road and Nebia-Coningsby Road west of Mackay. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$2.8 million** towards the project.



This additional funding addressed cost pressures and supported the full scope of works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$8.4 million**.
