# Warrego Highway Corridor

## Infrastructure Investment Program

<b>Corridor Description</b>	The Warrego Highway Corridor is broadly located on the National Land Transport Network in Queensland from the intersection with the Cunningham Highway to the Mitchell Highway intersection at Charleville.

## Projects within the Warrego Highway Corridor:

### Warrego Highway - Bremer River Bridge (Westbound) Strengthening

The project is undertaking bridge rehabilitation and strengthening works which are expected to allow the removal of the current operational traffic restrictions on the westbound bridge. Once completed it is expected that the bridge rehabilitation will improve productivity on this priority section of the National Land Transport Network and improve network access and safety.

### Warrego Highway - Mt Crosby Road Interchange - Planning

The project is expected to undertake the scoping phase of the Warrego Highway - Mt Crosby Road Interchange upgrade and will include community consultation, options analysis and the development of a business case in order to provide a more efficient, safe and reliable national highway network for regional and interstate freight and general traffic.

## **Warrego Highway - Mt Crosby Road Interchange Upgrade**

The project is expected to undertake the delivery phase of the Warrego Highway - Mt Crosby Road Interchange upgrade and is expected to improve capacity, reliability and safety on this priority section of the National Land Transport Network and uplift the Active Transport shared path network to current standards to improve connectivity.

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
