What

- RPM is a integrated business system to manage the Department's Infrastructure Investment Program (IIP)
- RPM uses a contemporary platform to manage the increasing scale and complexity of the IIP



Why

The Infrastructure Management System (IMS) is a bespoke legacy system and is not able to meet evolving business and reporting needs.



Benefits

- Improved accessibility and reliability of data
- Streamlined business processes
- Strengthened inter-governmental operations

View payments received

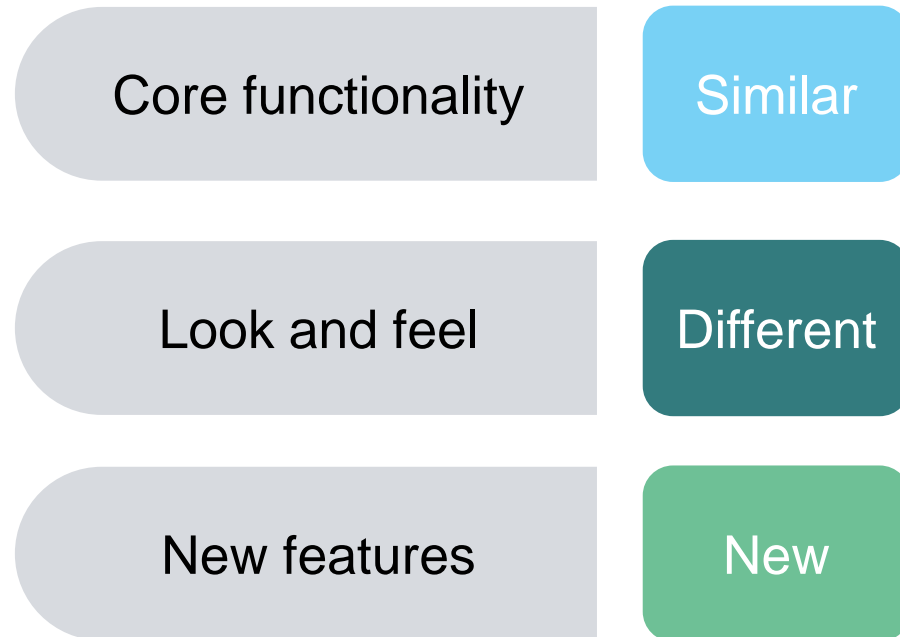

Data migration

- All current project information will be migrated

What will not be migrated

- Historical reports including
 - RTR 23/24 annual report
 - RTR 23/24 expenditure

Data availability

- IMS will shutdown from 6:00pm, 20 November 2025

Local preparation considerations

- Management of your programs based on advice on what to do and when
- Who will have access to the portal
- Updating any local documentation with RPM details
- Advise other areas of the transition from IMS to RPM
- Download any required reports from IMS

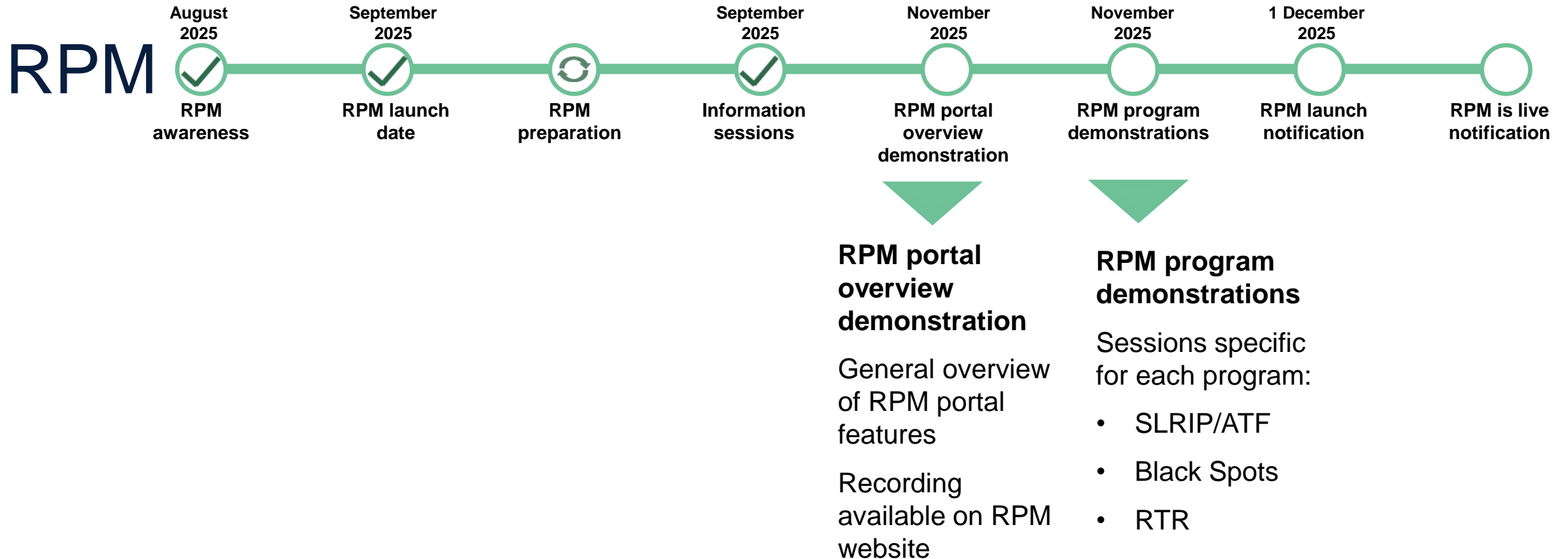
RPM portal access

Access process

- Complete and submit the RPM portal user access form by 7 November 2025
- Prior to RPM launch, you will receive:
 - RPM portal link
 - Password set up instructions
 - Multi Factor Authentication instructions
- Only RPM homepage will be visible prior to the launch
