



# Reporting and Program Management (RPM)

## Submit applications for Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure Program (SLRIP) and Heavy Vehicle Rest Area (HVRA) Initiatives

December 2025

This Quick Reference Guide (QRG) provides key steps for submitting applications for Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure Program (SLRIP) and Heavy Vehicle Rest Area (HVRA) Initiatives. The application process in the RPM portal is similar to the Roads to Recovery application process. Refer to the RPM portal user guide – RTR for detailed instructions.

### Instructions

1. Select the **Project Applications** tile on the RPM portal homepage.
2. **Draft Applications** with a **Submit By Date** in the future can be updated and submitted. All **Draft Applications** can be deleted.
3. **Submitted Applications** lists applications that are Under Assessment or Not Approved for the Account. As SLRIP/HVRA initiatives are part of a competitive funding round, these Applications are not visible to other Accounts.
4. **Approved Applications** will no longer be visible in this page as they are moved to the relevant State or Territory account for administrative management.
