The Australian Government is committed to ensuring the sustainability of the 10-year, over \$120 billion infrastructure investment pipeline, delivering nationally significant projects while considering the impacts of inflation and cost of living pressures on Australians.

Through the 2024-25 MYEFO, the Government is focused on managing cost pressures by implementing strategies for existing projects and maintaining our commitment to responsible financial management.

\$4 million has been committed towards an existing project to ensure the continued delivery of this essential road infrastructure upgrade.

As at 2024-25 MYEFO, the Government's total commitment to South Australia under the Infrastructure Investment Program, over the next 10-years is \$9.9 billion, including \$8.9 billion towards major road and rail projects and \$1.0 billion for smaller projects and programs such as the Roads to Recovery, Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure and the Black Spots programs.

The Government remains dedicated to working for all Australians by delivering nationally significant infrastructure projects that enhance productivity and resilience, improve liveability, and promote sustainability.

Project receiving additional funding

Through the 2024–25 MYEFO, the Australian Government is providing **\$4 million** to support the delivery of an existing project.

Rural Roads Package - Safety Package

This project will deliver safety upgrades that will improve road conditions along several critical country roads in rural South Australia. This project will also construct overtaking lanes on the Augusta Highway, Lincoln Highway, Riddoch Highway, Victor Harbor Road and Long Valley Road. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$4 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will allow further road improvement works to be delivered. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$128.4 million**.
