## Projects within the Midland Highway Corridor:

### Midland Highway Upgrade - Oatlands (Jericho to South of York Plains)

This project includes road widening, shoulder sealing, additional overtaking lanes and installation of flexible safety barriers on the Midland Highway to improve safety outcomes from Jericho to South of York Plains.

### Midland Highway - Campbell Town North (Campbell Town to Epping Forest)

This project includes road widening, shoulder sealing, additional overtaking lanes and installation of flexible safety barriers on the Midland Highway to improve safety outcomes from Campbell Town to Epping Forest. The project will improve the safety on the highway and achieve a minimum 3 Star AusRAP Safety Rating.

### Midland Highway Upgrade - Ross (Mona Vale Road to Campbell Town)

This project includes road widening, shoulder sealing, additional overtaking lanes and installation of flexible safety barriers on the Midland Highway to improve safety outcomes from Mona Vale Road to Campbell Town. The project will improve the safety on the highway and achieve a minimum 3 Star AusRAP Safety Rating.
