## Infrastructure Investment Program

2024–25 MYEFO

**Supporting priority land transport infrastructure projects.**

The Australian Government is committed to ensuring the sustainability of the 10-year, over \$120 billion infrastructure investment pipeline, delivering nationally significant projects while considering the impacts of inflation and cost of living pressures on Australians.

Through the 2024-25 MYEFO, the Government is focused on managing cost pressures by implementing strategies for existing projects and maintaining our commitment to responsible financial management.

Nearly **\$14 million** has been committed towards existing projects to ensure the continued delivery of essential road infrastructure upgrades within Tasmania.

As at 2024-25 MYEFO, the Government's total commitment to Tasmania under the Infrastructure Investment Program, over the next 10-years is **\$2.2 billion**, including **\$1.9 billion** towards major road and rail projects and around **\$360 million** for smaller projects and programs such as the Roads to Recovery, Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure and the Black Spots programs.

The Government remains dedicated to working for all Australians by delivering nationally significant infrastructure projects that enhance productivity and resilience, improve liveability, and promote sustainability.

# Projects receiving additional funding

Through the 2024–25 MYEFO, the Australian Government has committed **\$13.8 million** to support the delivery of existing projects.

## Bridport Road Freight Efficiency and Safety Upgrades

The project will deliver improved freight productivity and access to freight gateways on Bridport Road as well as improving road safety, efficiency and network reliability for all road users. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$4 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will support the delivery of further safety improvements to Bridport Road, including pavement rehabilitation, road widening and improvements to junctions. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$20 million**.

## Murchison Highway Corridor Upgrade

The project will deliver upgrades such as bridge strengthening, road widening, shoulder sealing, and intersection improvements to support freight movement across the Murchison Highway corridor. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$4 million** towards the project.



The additional funding will provide opportunity to deliver further safety improvements along the Murchison and Zeehan Highways such as additional overtaking lanes, shoulder sealing and curve-widening works. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$39 million**.

## Devonport to Cradle Mountain - Planning

The project will provide planning for safety upgrades to the corridor between the outskirts of Devonport and Cradle Mountain. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$3.8 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will support the further planning and concept design work for further improvement opportunities along the corridor while also expanding the scope to include integration of transportation options at the ends of the corridor such as planning work for the Cradle Valley cableway. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$6.3 million**.

## Hobart Public Transport Infrastructure Planning

The project will plan upgrades to Hobart's public, active and marine transport networks including the Hobart Rapid Bus Network between major centres along key corridors, enabling public transport infrastructure, bus stations and ferry terminals. The Australian Government has committed an additional **\$2 million** towards the project.



This additional funding will support opportunities to undertake further public transport planning on the Northern Suburbs Transit Corridor. The total Australian Government commitment towards the project is now **\$40.5 million**.
