Funding

The Australian Government has committed an additional \$3.8 billion towards this project. The new Australian Government commitment to the project is \$6.0 billion:

Project Scope

The project will deliver a 26 kilometre underground orbital rail line through Melbourne's eastern and south-eastern suburbs, creating interchanges with four of Melbourne's established radial rail lines at Cheltenham, Glen Waverley, Box Hill and Clayton, and connecting rail lines in four directions including regional V/Line services on the Gippsland Line. It will also bring new rail connections to currently unserved areas with new stations at Burwood and Monash.
