Projects within the Great Eastern Highway Corridor:

Great Eastern Highway - Walgoolan Southern Cross and Coates Gully

The project replaced one bridge along the Great Eastern Highway from Walgoolan to Southern Cross, including upgrading road approaches. The Coates Gully Section of works replaced, widened and realigned three bridges in Coates Gully, including an upgrade to the existing road approaches, and provided the formation for overtaking lanes.

Great Eastern Highway Upgrades - Coates Gully, Walgoolan to Southern Cross and Ghooli to Benari

The project involves upgrading the Great Eastern Highway at Coates Gully, Walgoolan to Southern Cross, and Ghooli to Benari. Project works include realignments of sub-standard curves, intersection improvements, provision of passing lanes and seal widening.
