## Projects within the Great Eastern Highway Corridor:

### Great Eastern Highway Upgrades - Coates Gully, Walgoolan to Southern Cross and Ghooli to Benari

The project involves upgrading the Great Eastern Highway at Coates Gully, Walgoolan to Southern Cross, and Ghooli to Benari. Project works include realignments of sub-standard curves, intersection improvements, provision of passing lanes and seal widening.

### Great Eastern Highway – Walgoolan Southern Cross and Coates Gully

The project will replace, widen and realign two bridges along the Great Eastern Highway from Walgoolan to Southern Cross, including upgrading road approaches.

The Coates Gully Section of works will replace, widen and realign three bridges in Coates Gully, including an upgrade to the existing road approaches, and provide the formation for overtaking lanes.
