Project Scope

This project will undertake detailed planning for road upgrades to the next priority sections of the Great Northern Highway between Broome and Kununurra.

Key elements include developing business cases to inform future investment decisions, identifying priority upgrade options, and undertaking cost and risk analysis.

Funding

Total Commitment: \$8 million

Australian Government Commitment: \$4 million

Western Australia Government Commitment: \$4 million
