Projects within the Westport Corridor:

Westport - Kwinana Freeway Upgrades

The project will deliver upgrades to Kwinana Freeway to support the future operation of the new port (Westport) and improve safety and efficiency of the current road network.

Westport Project Development

This project will undertake the planning and development of landside infrastructure projects connected to the new Westport container port development.

Westport - Anketell Road Upgrades - Stage 1A and 1B

The project will upgrade Anketell Road from Leath Road to Abercrombie Road to four lanes, including a grade separation at Rockingham Road, associated road/road grade separation structures, intersection upgrades and tie-ins to connect the future container terminal and freight network.
