Project Scope

This project will upgrade Anketell Road from Leath Road to Abercrombie Road. This project builds on the current Australian Government investment of \$33.5 million for Westport Enabling Infrastructure Planning, and \$350 million for upgrades to Kwinana Freeway.

Key elements include widening to four lanes, a grade separation at Rockingham Road, associated grade separation structures, intersection upgrades and tie-ins to connect a future container terminal and freight network.
